# Access to the Naval Academy Yard & Services

## **Pedestrian Access**

Unless part of a special event, normal visitor access to the Naval Academy is from sunrise to sunset. During these periods visitors must use Visitor Gates 1, 3 or 8.

The Visitor Access Center is located by Gate 1 which is at the intersection of Randall Street and King George Street. Pedestrian entrances to Gate 1 can be found on Randall Street (between Prince George and King George Streets) and on Prince George Street at Craig Street. Both entrances are just a block or so from the Annapolis City Dock.

Gate 3 is located at the intersection of Maryland Avenue and Hanover Street and Gate 8 is located at the intersection of Bowyer Road and MD Rt. 450.

Everyone entering the yard 18 years and older must have a government-issued photo ID. Photocopies of ID (passports, ID Cards, etc.) cannot be accepted. Non-US citizens must present a passport.

Note that the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) has extended the REAL ID full enforcement date to May 3, 2023, due to circumstances resulting from the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. Therefore, all valid state driver's licenses are accepted for visitor access to Defense Department installations, including the Naval Academy.

#### **Vehicle Access**

Only vehicles with a USNA ID Card or a DOD credential, including military retirees and dependents may drive onto Naval Academy Grounds.

Visitors with government-issued disability parking license plates or placards may be granted vehicle access at Gate 1 and Gate 8 during general visiting hours. The photo identification will be compared to the parking certification card that was issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles along with the issued disability parking placard.

For visitors without a locally prepared USNA ID Card or a DOD credential, all day parking is available in the **Noah Hillman Parking Garage** (accessible from Duke of Gloucester or Main Streets), at the **Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium** or at two-hour parking meters around City Dock.
