Current COVID-19 Polices for the USNA Class of 1971's 50th Reunion Events

- Masks must be worn while travelling on our reunion shuttle buses. It is an Anne Arundel County requirement for Public Transportation.
- Registration and the Welcome Aboard Reception at the DoubleTree Hotel on Thursday no restrictions (be advised hotel employees are required to wear masks).
- The only indoor event scheduled on the Yard for Friday is the Superintendent's Briefing in Alumni Hall at 1350 – 1500. Masks are required while inside Alumni Hall.
- Saturday afternoon tailgate outdoors and few restrictions see Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium COVID Policies below.
- Sunday afternoon events include the Memorial Service and Class Celebration 1600-1700 at the DoubleTree. Masks are recommended for the unvaccinated.
- Sunday evening Dahlgren Hall Class Dinner 1730 2200.
 - Wear masks while entering and departing the bus & Dahlgren Hall. Wear your 50th Name Tag.
 - All entering Dahlgren Hall must show proof of vaccination, or negative Covid test paperwork that was completed in the previous 72 hours, which means Sep 30, Oct 1, or Oct 2.

 <u>Airport</u>: offers travelers an opportunity to get a Rapid or PCR COVID-19 test. First
 Call Medical Center is located inside the main terminal near Concourse C, behind
 the Jet Blue counter and outside of security, so a boarding pass isn't needed, nor is
 an appointment as walk-ins are welcome.
